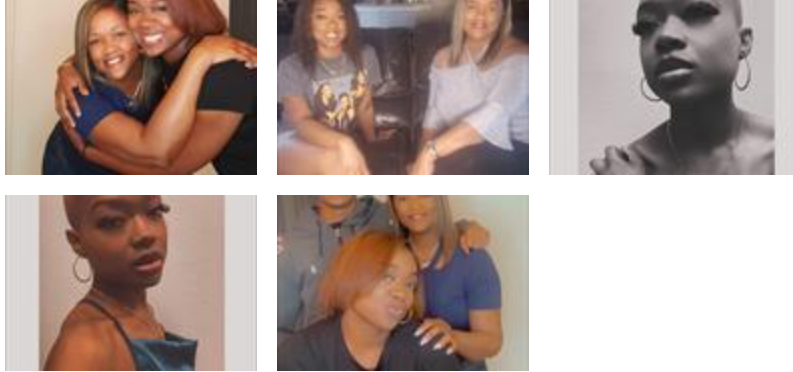
Her memory will forever live on in the hearts of those who loved her. The family wishes to remember Courtney as she was: independent, creative, and
